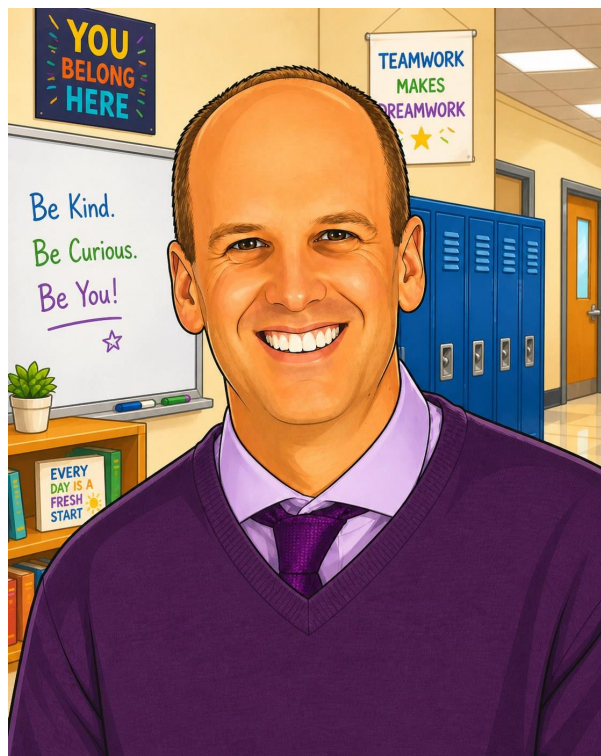

Explorer Class



Explorer Class have had a very exciting couple of weeks, last week we went on our first school outing to the bridge over the big road to do a traffic survey. The children made tallies to represent the numbers of the different types of vehicles they could see and loved waving at the passing traffic. Several of the drivers, especially the lorry drivers, waving back and tooted their horns, much to the children's delight! Mrs Wallis and Mrs Scott were so proud of their exemplary sensible behaviour when walking to and from our survey point.

Another exciting event last week was when two huge boxes were delivered to the school which the children decided to turn into buses, in keeping with this term's transport theme. They worked together fantastically to decorate the boxes inside and out before 'going' on an adventure in them.

This Tuesday the children were excited to see that the classroom had been turned into an aeroplane in the afternoon, complete with a visit from EasyJet cabin crew. We learnt all about the safety briefing, parts of the aeroplane, the captain's flightdeck and the snack trolley! We then investigated making paper planes and flying them outside, adapting our folds to try and make them fly further.

We have also been creating our own aeroplanes using junk modelling, incorporating flange joints to attach the different components together. The children had some very ingenious alternative designs for their flying machines!

Discovery Class



What a busy week!

This week in Maths, we have been working with numbers and exploring doubles and near doubles. The children have enjoyed using practical resources and games to help build their

confidence. We are now beginning to move on to place value, focusing on understanding tens and ones.

In English, we have linked our writing to our Geography learning by exploring the oceans of the world. The children have enjoyed learning new facts and vocabulary linked to ocean habitats and adventures. Next week, we will be writing an exciting invitation for a submarine adventure, using adjectives and descriptive language to help persuade the reader.

In PE, we have been practising how to use a tennis racket and developing our control when bouncing a ball. The children showed great determination and coordination during these activities.

Next week, we are also looking forward to starting our DT learning, where the children will be designing their very own fruit salad.

Voyager Class





It's been another fantastic few weeks in Year 2. Our Forest School sessions continue to be the highlight of our week and we were very lucky to see a slow worm last week! We thought it was a snake at first!

We have been thrilled to watch our bean seeds germinate and grow rapidly under our care in the classroom. The children know how to look after their plants and will now be taking them home to continue their journey with them. We look forward to hearing any updates on how big they get and maybe the children could share a photo too!

Odyssey Class



Over the past fortnight, Odyssey Class has been busy with lots of hands-on learning.

In Science, we planted broad beans on cotton wool and have been observing how they grow by counting roots and shoots. Some have grown really well, while others haven't, helping us understand that plants need the right conditions to thrive. We also carried out a celery experiment, placing stalks in water with blue dye and watching as the colour travelled up through the plant - we even cut the celery to see the changes inside!

In Art, as part of our Telling Stories Through Drawing and Making Art topic, we have started making clay tortoises, based on the story 'Esio Trot'. The children have shown great creativity, and we're looking forward to painting them later this term.

PE has been full of energy, with the class really enjoying cricket and athletics.

On Wednesday we had a visit from Dave from the Wiltshire and Berkshire Canal Trust, who taught us all about how canals work. The children were fascinated by how locks move water. Thank you so much to Dave at the Wiltshire and Berkshire Canal Trust for giving up their time.

We have also had lots to celebrate in Odyssey Class this fortnight - from football and rugby achievements to fantastic dancing, as well as many kind acts and consistently great behaviour for learning. A special shout-out goes to Henry and Miss Harvey, who took part in the Race for Life Pretty Muddy 5km. Together, they have raised an amazing £350 for Cancer Research UK - an incredible achievement!

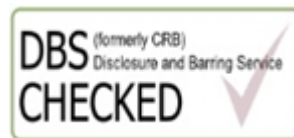



