## St Peter's Academy on Social Media



It is great to see the school getting positive publicity through our Facebook and Instagram accounts. We have taken advice from our trust's safeguarding expert, Sarah Turner, about whether or not these should be public or private accounts. She has informed us that as one of their primary purposes is to advertise the school, they should not be private. We have been given very clear guidance about the safe use of photos on these accounts - no frontal facial images of children will be used and parents can withdraw consent for use of any images of their children (which would be back of the head shots) on social media at any time. Our website will also be changed in the future - the trust will be issuing guidance on this shortly.

## Explorer Class



Explorer Class are busy travelling around the world this term. We have learnt that there are 7 continents and have a catchy song to help us remember them. We have explored Asia as the largest continent this week, looking at China in particular. The children had made flags, designed willow pattern plates, built Great Walls and found out about pandas. Then we have celebrated with a fabulous Chinese buffet. We explored using chopsticks and tasting new foods. The children were excited to open their fortune cookies and find out their fortunes - lots of happy, lucky and wealthy futures ahead!

## Discovery Class



This week we started our outdoor learning sessions in the forest! Although the weather has been a little wet, we have had lots of fun minibeast hunting and exploring our five senses. The children enjoyed making smelly potions and even had the chance to taste some strawberries and raspberries as part of our sensory learning activities.

In Maths, we have continued learning about coins and what they represent. We compared different coins and explored their values, identifying which coins hold the most value and discussing how we know. During activity time the children have had the opportunity to use money in context with our food shop!

In English, we have been focusing on our story *Tom's Marvellous Machines*. We explored the ups and downs of the text, identifying the problems and solutions throughout the story. This has prepared us well for our retelling of the story next week.

## Voyager Class



It has been a fantastic start to the final term of the year. At just 2 weeks in we have been learning to tell the time, looked at seaside holidays, looked at different scientists and investigated their discoveries with gravity and light and have really enjoyed getting to know our class book - 'Nen and the lonely fisherman'. The children have really matured and are approaching their learning with so much energy and enthusiasm whilst building independence and curiosity too.

Our highlight was our visit to Hardenhuish on Friday for a Scavenger Hunt. The children excelled themselves on so many levels. They showed great sporting abilities as they ran around the field demonstrating their orienteering skills, fabulous teamwork and communication and excellent behaviours, which were recognised and commented on. It

was a pleasure taking the children out and seeing them thrive as a group in a different setting.

We have a very exciting term ahead and look forward to all the extra events we have going on, starting with our class assembly next week, Sports day and a trip later in the term.

## Odyssey Class



What a busy start to the final term in Year 3! In English, we have begun exploring the book *A Hero Like Me*. We started by discussing who our heroes are and who we believe deserves to be celebrated with a statue. The children shared some thoughtful ideas and had some excellent discussions.

We also enjoyed a special non-uniform day on Wednesday after Orla was lucky enough to win a Golden Ticket – a fantastic treat for the whole class!

In Maths, we are continuing to develop our understanding of fractions, building on our knowledge through a range of practical and problem-solving activities.

Our new DT topic this term is all about designing chocolate bar packaging. Of course, every good designer needs to do their research, so we explored a variety of existing packaging designs and even carried out a little taste test to help inspire our ideas!

We have also been busy creating our entry for the Kington Langley Scarecrow Festival, taking place on 20th–21st June. This year's theme is *The Sea*, and the children have been working hard to bring our creation to life. Come along to the festival and see if you can guess what we have made!

## Navigator Class



Navigator Class have been working really hard in preparation for the Times Table Check, and all of their effort has truly paid off – they all did brilliantly!

It has also been a busy and exciting week across our foundation subjects. In History, we have been debating ancient Greek democracy, confidently sharing our thoughts and ideas and considering different viewpoints. In Art, we have been getting creative by making clay sculptures, developing our skills and experimenting with different techniques.

As a reward for our efforts last week, we enjoyed wearing our slippers to school on Monday. Thankfully, we all remembered to take them off before swimming!

We have also loved listening to Greek myths and have become experts at classifying animals in Science. It has been wonderful to see everyone showing such enthusiasm and curiosity in their learning. Well done, Navigator Class, for another fantastic week!

## Pioneer Class



Pioneer Class have been exploring a range of engaging and thought-provoking topics across the curriculum. In Art, pupils have been learning about architecture, with a particular focus on the “tiny house movement.” They have discussed how homes can be designed creatively while making efficient use of space and resources.

In English, we have been studying the powerful picture book *Rose Blanche*. The children have explored the themes of this text with great maturity, developing their understanding of empathy, perspective, and the impact of war on individuals.

Our Guided Reading sessions have introduced a text about the First World War, helping pupils to understand the key events that led up to it. This has provided important context for our History learning, where we have been examining how the Treaty of Versailles contributed to the outbreak of the Second World War. We have also looked at the different countries involved with WWII, identifying the Allies and Axis powers. The class have shown excellent curiosity and thoughtful discussion skills throughout these topics.

We are also incredibly proud of our Year 5 girl football leaders, who have recently launched their own football club for both KS1 and KS2 pupils. They led a fantastic first session, demonstrating confidence, teamwork, and leadership skills, with an impressive turnout of children taking part.

## Endeavour Class



Endeavour Class have had a super busy first few weeks of term. We have jumped straight in with rehearsals and are already very excited about performing our play of Madagascar for you. We have started exploring Crime and Punishment in History - starting with the Romans. The children were particularly engaged with the topic and had lots of existing knowledge! In writing, we have been focused on writing a persuasive text from the point of view of Alex or Marty, persuading the other animals to either go back to New York or return to Madagascar. In Maths, we have been exploring expression, balancing equations and solving  $x$ . In RE, we have starting looking at our Creation topic: Conflicting or Complimentary - where we look an religious and scientific views of creation.

A highlight has been going to the Blue Kite Games. The children were all very positive and supportive of each other. We had a fantastic afternoon and enjoyed celebrating 3 medals!!

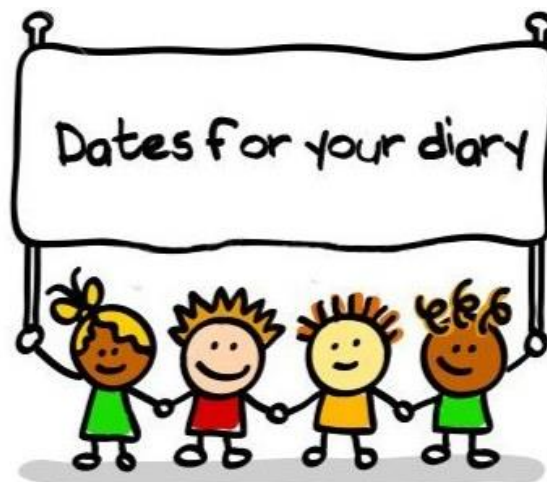



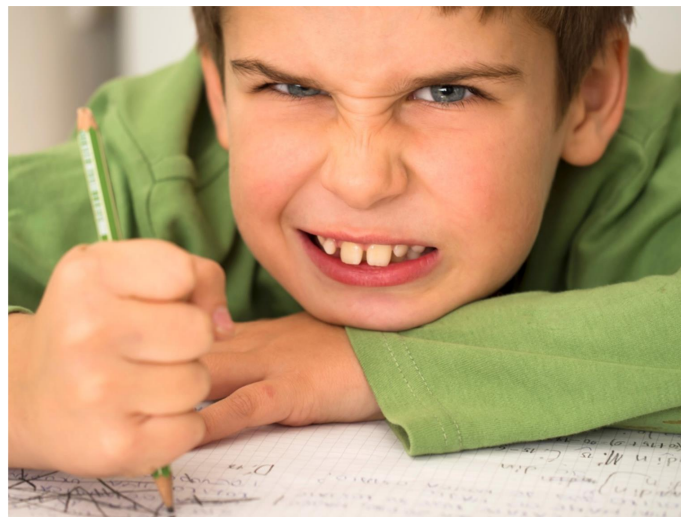
