Have a great weekend and I look forward to seeing many of you at the fete,

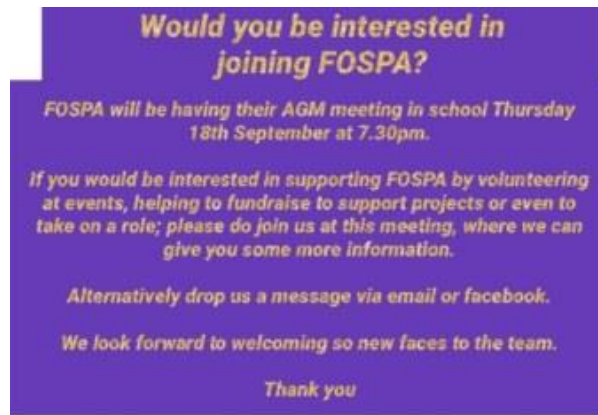

Everyday next week at 3.10 each class will have their lost & found box outside the classroom. Please do have a look to see if any of the found items might belong to you.

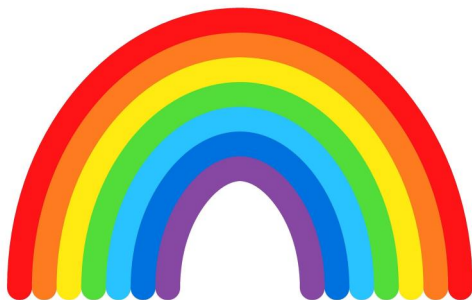
Class photo order reminder

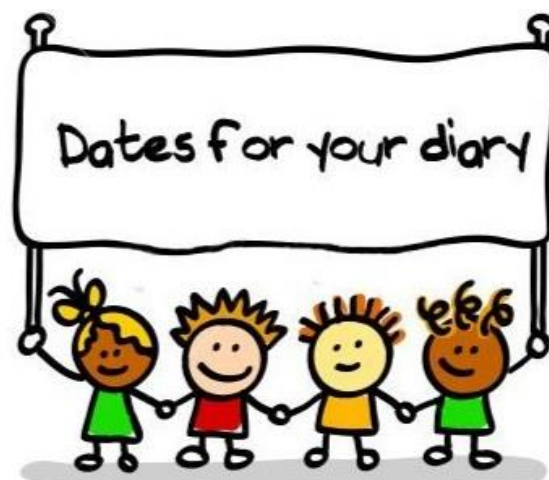
