



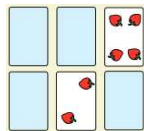
Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Please log into Tapestry and view your child's learning in school. We would also love to see what they get up to at home too.

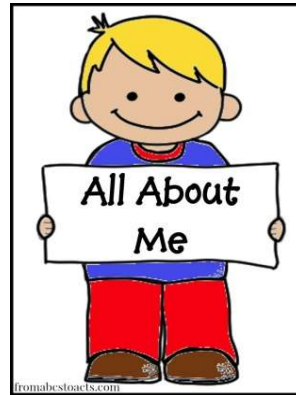
Communication and Language
